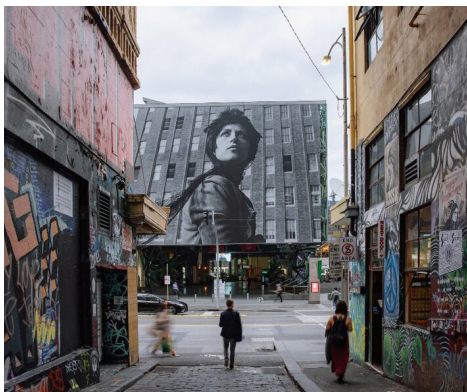
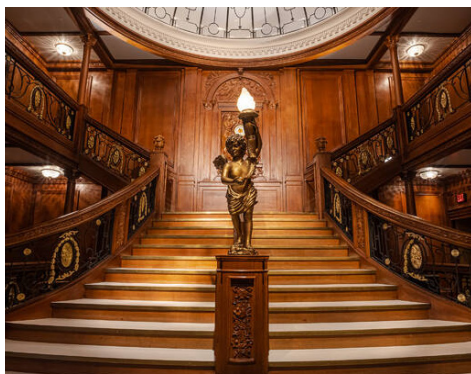


Photo 2024: International Festival of Photography Until 24th March
