### Melbourne Writers Festival 8th - 12 May

# Chicago the Musical at Her Majesty's Theatre Until 26th May

#### NGV Architecture Commission: This is Air Until 16th June 2024

"This is Air" is an outdoor art installation created by Nic Brunsdon in collaboration with ENESS. The artwork utilises air as a building material to create a large spherical structure in the NGV Garden. Throughout the day, the spherical structure expands and releases air in a natural rhythm, changing its shape and exuding gusts of air. It highlights our connection to and dependence on the finite resource whose quality is being increasingly affected.



# The Art of the Brick Immersive Experience Until 30th June 2024

The Art of the Brick Immersive Experience LEGO exhibition is returning to Melbourne. It features over one million bricks and showcases 100+ sculptures in a 360-degree environment with 3D video mapping and an uplifting score. Highlights include a giant "Yellow" sculpture, an installation with 250 kinetic LEGO skulls, and a 400 sq m immersive gallery called "Perniciem" in collaboration with photographer Dean West.
